HEALTH RECORD REQUIREMENTS

Assalamualikum Parents:

Physical exams are required for all students entering Preschool (3&4 yrs. old), Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grades, all children entering school for the first time, and all students new to Illinois schools. Physicals should be completed between August 9, 2016 and August 9, 2017. DUE IN OFFICE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL (AUGUST 09, 2017).

- 1. <u>Certificate of Child Health Exam:</u> *Parent/guardian completes*: <u>Pg. 1</u>-Student Name and Information <u>Pg. 2</u>- Student Name and Information; Health History; Signature. *Physicians' office to complete*: <u>Pg.1</u>-Immunizations and Screenings with signatures <u>Pg.2</u>- Physical Exam Requirements and Screenings with signature-including Diabetes screening, BMI, lead screening for Pre-K (3&4) and Kindergarten, and Physical Education checked yes or no. *(Parents please use the latest Health Form available on Plus Portals.)*
- 2. <u>Immunizations:</u> complete record of all required immunizations including month, day, and year, and signed by a nurse or doctor:
 - <u>Dtap Vaccine:</u> Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.)- 4 doses at correct intervals. K-12: 4 or more doses at correct intervals.
 - <u>Tdap Booster:</u> 6-12 students must show proof of ONE Tdap booster regardless of the interval since the last DTaP,
 DT or Td.
 - Polio Vaccine: Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 3 doses at correct intervals. K-12: 4 or more doses at correct intervals.
 - <u>HIB Vaccine</u>: Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) Has received the primary series of Hib vaccine according to the Hib vaccination schedule or a single dose of Hib vaccine between 15-59 months of age.
 - Hepatitis B Vaccine: Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 3 doses at correct intervals. 6-12: 3 doses at correct intervals.
 - Varicella (Chicken Pox): Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 1 dose on or after 1st birthday. K-12: 2 doses at correct intervals.
 - MMR Vaccine -Measles, Mumps and Rubella: Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 1 dose on or after 1st birthday but prior to 24 months of age. K-12: 2 doses at correct intervals.
 - Invasive Pneumococcal Vaccine: Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) Has received the primary series of pneumococcal conjugate vaccine according to the vaccine schedule or a single dose of pneumococcal vaccine between 24-59 months of age.
 - Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine: Grade 6, 7 & 8: One dose received on or after 10th birthday. Grade 12: 2
 doses received unless the first dose was administered after 16 years of age (No proof of immunity allowed).
- 3. <u>Dental Exams:</u> are required for students entering KG, 2 and 6 grades. DUE IN OFFICE BY MARCH 15, 2018.
- 4. <u>Vision Exam</u> is required for KG, 2 and 8 grade students and all students new to Illinois schools. An eye Doctor, (ophthalmologist or a licensed optometrist) must perform the required eye exam. **DUE IN OFFICE BY OCTOBER 1, 2017.**
